

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to extending the sunset provision that will repeal Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) 85.02, which regulates dwelling in vehicles on City streets.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (O'Farrell - Wesson):

REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present an Ordinance to extend LAMC Section 85.02 for six months and to include in the Ordinance an Urgency Clause given the pending expiration of the section.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has submitted a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary
