

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to amending the Council Action of October 1, 2014 to modify the City Engineer's conditions of the vacation of a portion of the southeasterly side of Reseda Boulevard from approximately 140 feet northeasterly of Sunset Boulevard.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Bonin - Buscaino):

AMEND the Council Action of October 1, 2014, Council file No. 14-1090, relative to the vacation of a portion of the southeasterly side of Reseda Boulevard from approximately 140 feet northeasterly of Sunset Boulevard (VAC-E1401234), to delete the condition detailed below set forth in the City Engineer's report dated August 19, 2014 and adopt the following in lieu thereof:

CONDITION TO BE DELETED

7. That consents to the vacation be secured from the owners of lots adjoining the area to be vacated.

CONDITION TO BE ADOPTED

7. That consents to the vacation be secured from the owners of lots adjoining the area to be vacated, except from owners of those lots which adjoin the area being vacated through a previously vacated portion of Reseda Boulevard.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on February 18, 2015, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee considered a Motion (Bonin - Buscaino) relative to amending the Council Action of October 1, 2014 to modify the City Engineer's conditions of the vacation of a portion of the southeasterly side of Reseda Boulevard from approximately 140 feet northeasterly of Sunset Boulevard.

An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the Motion as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
