Summary:

On October 7, 2014, your Committee considered an August 27, 2014 EWDD report relative to a request for exemption for two positions pursuant to Charter Section 1001(d)(4). According to the EWDD, at its February 13, 2014 meeting, the Board of Civil Service Commissioners approved the civil service exemption for two Workforce Investment Act Annual Plan positions. These positions perform administrative and program duties, supporting the Department's Federal, State, and local grants.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval to exempt two positions as described in the August 27, 2014 EWDD report and detailed in the above recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
