

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to prohibiting the parking of oversized vehicles on East 119th Street between Avalon Boulevard and Stanford Avenue.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Resolution (Buscaino – Huizar):

1. RESOLVE, pursuant to the Los Angeles Municipal Codes Section 80.69.4, to hereby prohibit the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 84 inches in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., along East 119th Street between Avalon Boulevard and Stanford Avenue.
2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon approval of this action, to post signs giving notice of a Tow Away, No Parking restriction for oversized vehicles, with the specific hours detailed, at the above location.
3. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this action.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On October 7, 2014, Council considered Resolution (Buscaino – Huizar) relative to prohibiting the parking of oversized vehicles along South Hoover Street between 182nd Street and the terminus of South Hoover Street, and East 119th Street between Avalon Boulevard and Stanford Avenue. Resolution states that the Harbor Gateway community is experiencing public safety issues associated with large vehicles that are parked overnight and constrict travel lanes, thereby creating dangerous situations. Resolution makers recommend that Council authorize the needed oversized vehicle parking restrictions. Council referred Resolution to the Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held January 28, 2015, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve Resolution, as amended to delete South Hoover Street between 182nd Street and the terminus of South Hoover Street inasmuch as more restrictive parking restrictions have already been posted on this street segment.
