The Council District 13 Public Benefits Trust Fund/Hollywood Mobility Trust Fund Account provides funding for studies, plans and projects related to transportation, in order to enhance the overall mobility network in Hollywood.

The Department of Transportation will be installing flashing 24/7 beacons at the intersection of Fountain and Bronson Avenues in order to increase the visibility of the crosswalk and improve pedestrian safety for students of Le Conte Middle School and Citizens of the World Charter School, as well as all other groups walking in the area. This effort is of special benefit for the residents of the City and for Council District 13 and deserves financial assistance from the City.

Sufficient funds are available in the Council District 13 Public Benefits Trust Fund/Hollywood Mobility Trust Fund Account, which could be transferred to the Department of Transportation for these purposes.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council AUTHORIZE the Controller to transfer \$8,400 from Council District 13 Public Benefits Trust Fund No. 904, Hollywood Mobility Trust Fund Account No. 14K052 to Department of Transportation Fund No. 100/94 for flashing beacons at Fountain and Bronson Avenues, as follows:
