**MOTION**

The Council District 13 Public Benefits Trust Fund/Hollywood Mobility Trust Fund Account provides funding for studies, plans and projects related to transportation, in order to enhance the mobility network in Hollywood.

The Hollywood Christmas Parade began in 1928 and is held annually the Sunday after Thanksgiving. This year's parade will be held on Sunday, November 30, 2014. Each year, the Hollywood Christmas Parade attracts thousands of visitors to the area, as well as millions more viewers who follow the parade on television.

As a means of adequately controlling the large crowds that come to Hollywood for the Christmas Parade, the Department of Transportation has painted special blue demarcation lines along the parade route, which runs along Hollywood and Sunset Boulevards between Orange Drive and Vine Street, and on Vine Street between Hollywood and Sunset Boulevards. In recent years, due to resurfacing and other factors, these lines have faded. In order to ensure the safety of the expected large number of spectators for this year's parade, as well as subsequent parades, the demarcation lines along the parade route should be re-stripped as soon as possible. This effort will be of special benefit for the residents of the City and for Council District 13 and deserve financial assistance from the City.

The blue demarcation line should be restriped along the parade route on Hollywood Boulevard between Orange Drive and Vine Street, on Vine Street between Hollywood and Sunset Boulevards, and on Sunset Boulevard between Vine Street and Cahuenga Boulevard. Sufficient funds are available in the Council District 13 Public Benefits Trust Fund/Hollywood Mobility Trust Fund Account, which could be transferred to the Department of Transportation for these purposes.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council AUTHORIZE the Controller to transfer \$10,000 from Council District 13 Public Benefits Trust Fund No. 904, Hollywood Mobility Trust Fund Account No. 14K052 to Department of Transportation Fund No. 100/94 for the restriping of these blue demarcation lines, as follows:

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Transportation be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above fund transfer instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
