PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the 2014 Los Angeles Marathon Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Activation After Action Report/Corrective Action Plan.

Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE the Emergency Operations Board (EOB) report to the Mayor dated October 14, 2014 (attached to the Council file), relative to the 2014 Los Angeles Marathon EOC Activation After Action Report/Corrective Action Plan.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the EOB. Neither the City Administrative Officer or the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In the October 14, 2014, report to the Mayor, the EOB states that the EOC was activated to provide effective Citywide coordination of information and resources for the 2014 Los Angeles Marathon. The Emergency Management Department consulted with the Los Angeles Police and Fire Departments, and the Office of the Mayor during pre-event planning. The EOB report identifies the departments involved and a chronology of activities. It also provides recommendations of corrective actions specific to the activation of the EOC.

At its meeting held January 23, 2015, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council approve the EOB's After Action Report.
