# MOTION

On February 11, 2015, the City Council voted 11 Yes to 3 No not to concur with the operator selected by the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners as the highest-ranked proposer in the request for proposal (RFP) for operation and management of the Greek Theatre, and to request that the Board consider preparing, in consultation with the community, a new RFP to be released after review and approval by the City Council (City Council File No. 14-1500).

In response, on March 11, 2014, the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners approved Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) General Manager's Report No. 15-049, canceling the RFP pursuant to Charter Section 371. At a subsequent meeting held on April 15, 2015, the Board also approved RAP General Manager's Report No. 15-082, adopting a proposed open venue operational plan for the Greek Theatre in lieu of a new RFP.

Many questions have been raised about how this open venue operational plan would work and it is appropriate that we receive a briefing from the Department of Recreation and Parks on this plan.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Department of Recreation and Parks be directed to report to the full Council at the meeting of Tuesday, April 28, 2015 on how an open venue operational plan for the Greek Theatre would work, including all related and outstanding issues that may arise from switching to this new approach.
