

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to naming the intersection of 48th Street and South Gramercy Place as Bishop Hamel Hartford Brookins and Bishop T. Larry Kirkland Square.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Buscaino for Parks - O'Farrell):

1. DESIGNATE the intersection of 48th Street and South Gramercy Place as Bishop Hamel Hartford Brookins and Bishop T. Larry Kirkland Square.
2. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to erect permanent ceremonial sign(s) to this effect at this location.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on February 4, 2015, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee considered a Motion (Buscaino for Parks - O'Farrell) relative to naming the intersection of 48th Street and South Gramercy Place as Bishop T. Larry Kirkland Square. Staff from Council District Eight gave an overview of the matter. The staff member stated that this intersection was previously named in honor of Bishop Hamel Hartford Brookins. The staff member requested that the intersection of 48th Street and South Gramercy Place be named as Bishop Hamel Hartford Brookins and Bishop T. Larry Kirkland Square.

An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the Motion and modified in Committee as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
