MOTION

Leonard J. Aube, a much respected participant in the philanthropic community, has made a career of making the world a better place. As the Executive Director of the Annenberg Foundation, Mr. Aube guided the Annenberg Foundation in awarding over \$4.3 billion in grants to more than 3,100 nonprofits in 35 countries, in a wide range of program areas.


In 2013, the City Council approved a lease agreement between the Port of Los Angeles and the Rockefeller Philanthropy Advisors to transform a pier on the LA Waterfront in San Pedro into an urban marine research and innovation center called AltaSea. Mr. Aube has been pivotal in developing this public-private partnership with the Port of Los Angeles and bringing AltaSea to fruition.


To date, funding commitments for Phase 1 of the project total \$82 million, including \$57 million in site-related capital investments from the Port of Los Angeles and a \$25 million gift from the Annenberg Foundation. Phase 1 has a \$185 million cost estimate with a 2018 completion goal.

The AltaSea public-private partnership represents an unprecedented collaboration among government, business, marine science, education and philanthropy for conducting targeted research on marine and ocean-related problems, particularly those with significant socio-economic impact with tangible benefits to the Los Angeles region. AltaSea will be a leading, world-class urban marine research and innovation center at the Port of Los Angeles.

In recognition of Mr. Aube's tireless efforts to establish this transformative ocean science campus focused on the world's most pressing issues on pollution, food, energy and water, it is appropriate for the street in front of the future AltaSea campus to be named "Leonard Aube Way."

I THEREFORE MOVE that the portion of 22<sup>nd</sup> Street between Signal Street and Miner Street, in San Pedro, be named "Leonard Aube Way," and that the Department of Transportation be directed to erect permanent ceremonial sign(s) to this effect at this location.
