

RULES, ELECTIONS, INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS, AND NEIGHBORHOODS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding S. 2157 (Boxer), the Safe Drone Act of 2015, which would make it a misdemeanor to operate a drone in certain areas.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Wesson - Englander - Martinez), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2015-16 Federal Legislative Program SUPPORT for S. 2157 (Boxer), the Safe Drone Act on 2015, which would make it a misdemeanor to operate a drone in certain areas.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on February 16, 2016, the Rules, Elections, Intergovernmental Relations, and Neighborhoods Committee considered Resolution (Wesson - Englander - Martinez) and a report from the CLA dated January 11, 2016 relative to establishing the City's position regarding S. 2157 (Boxer), the Safe Drone Act of 2015, which would make it a misdemeanor to operate a drone in certain areas. The CLA report attached to the Council file provides additional background information and a summary of the Resolution.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the accompanying Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
