

RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding AB 1301(Jones-Sawyer and Alejo), preclearance of Local Voting-Related Changes.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2015-16 State Legislative Program OPPOSITION to AB 1301 (Jones-Sawyer and Alejo) which would make various changes to City voting-related laws, regulations, and/or policies, subject to the approval of the Secretary of State, prior to implementation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its meeting of June 19, 2015, the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a CLA report and accompanying Resolution relative to establishing the City's position to oppose AB 1301 (Jones-Sawyer and Alejo) which would make various changes to City voting-related laws, regulations, and/or policies, subject to the approval of the Secretary of State, prior to implementation. The CLA report, attached to the Council file, provides additional background information and a summary of the Resolution.
