Community Impact Statement: None submitted.


SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on Friday, August 21, 2015, the Rules, Elections, Intergovernmental Relations, and Neighborhoods Committee considered Resolution (Englander - Buscaino - Blumenfield) relative to establishing the City's position to support administrative action by the full Board of Parole Hearings and/or Governor Brown to reverse the decision to grant parole to Voltaire Williams (Mr. Williams was convicted for his involvement in the death of a Los Angeles Police officer). The Resolution, attached to the Council file, provides additional background information.

After consideration and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the accompanying Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
