PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT to the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of barn wall replacements valued at \$17,303 for the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Metropolitan Division.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the donation of barn wall replacements valued at \$17,303, from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the benefit of the LAPD Metropolitan Division, and THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated May 21, 2015, attached to the Council file, the LAPD recommends that the Board approve the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of barn wall replacements valued at \$17,303 for the LAPD Metropolitan Division. The LAPD reports that the donation will be used to replace the current bam walls that have become damaged due to age and wear and tear over the past 20 years. The current bam walls could cause harm to the Mounted Platoon horses. This donation consists of sixteen walls and one box of replacement latches and will be installed by the manufacturer. Mr. Lloyd Blum, Facilities Management Division, has approved the bam walls and installation. The bam walls have a warranty for various material defects. Should the bam walls become inoperable, grant or booster funding will be sought for replacement. After further discussion of the matter, the Committee recommended that Council approve the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of barn wall replacements valued at \$17,303 for the LAPD Metropolitan Division, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
