PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of 80 licenses to access Geofeedia valued at \$60,000 for the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Information Technology Bureau.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the donation of 80 licenses to access Geofeedia valued at \$60,000, from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the benefit of the LAPD Information Technology Bureau, and THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated May 8, 2015, attached to the Council file, the LAPD recommends that the Board approve the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of 80 licenses to access Geofeedia valued at \$60,000 for the LAPD Information Technology Bureau. The LAPD reports that the donation will be used to purchase 80 licenses to the Geofeedia program, which will be used throughout the LAPD. The donation was solicited and vetted by Information Technology Bureau. The program will allow for the real-time data collection of videos and posts to social media to aid in investigations. After further discussion of the matter, the Committee recommended that Council approve the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of 80 licenses to access Geofeedia valued at \$60,000 for the LAPD Information Technology Bureau, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
