PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation in the amount of \$69,638.35 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation to support overtime, uniforms, and office supplies for officers and students from the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Operations-Central Bureau Juvenile Impact Program.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the donation of support overtime, uniforms, and office supplies valued at \$69,638.35, from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the benefit of the officers and students from the LAPD Operations-Central Bureau Juvenile Impact Program, and THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated July 22, 2015, attached to the Council file, the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) recommends that the Board approve the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation in the amount of \$69,638.35 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation to support overtime, uniforms, and office supplies for officers and students from the LAPD Operations-Central Bureau Juvenile Impact Program. The LAPD reports that the Los Angeles Police Foundation will provide the funding for the Juvenile Impact Program hosted by the LAPD. The Juvenile Impact Program is modeled on the concept of a public-private partnership to identify and provide intervention for students and youths who are at great risk of joining gangs or engaging in criminal activity. The program's multiple components, including a strong parental teaching component, make it unique. The classes are taught by LAPD officers and certified counselors, using proactive and innovative techniques to influence the youth in a positive direction. After further discussion of the matter, the Committee recommended that Council approve the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation in the amount of \$69,638.35 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation to support overtime, uniforms, and office supplies for officers and students from the LAPD Operations-Central Bureau Juvenile Impact Program, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
