DISCUSSION

The donation is for the benefit of the Los Angeles Police Department. The body-worn cameras will assist officers in providing accurate depictions of events for courtroom presentation, capturing potentially incriminating statements from suspects, documenting and reviewing statements from victims and witnesses, and obtaining actual time frames of events for reporting purposes. The digital evidence will be stored in a cloud and storage fees are included in the contract. It should be noted there are two separate grants/donations for body cameras that will be tracked separately.

Chief Information Officer Maggie Goodrich, Information Technology Bureau, has approved the purchase and use of the body-worn cameras for the Department. The body-worn cameras are covered with a one-year warranty for maintenance. Future donations will be sought should they become damaged or need repair. No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patents.

Administrative Services Bureau has reviewed the donation and determined that it has been submitted in accordance with Section 5.467 et seq. of the Los Angeles Administrative Code.
