

COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR AND MEMBER, PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE relative to a donation of registration fees for Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) personnel to attend the Los Angeles Women Police Officers and Associates 2015 Professional Training and Development Symposium.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept the donation of registration fees valued at \$35,000 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for LAPD personnel to attend the Los Angeles Women Police Officers and Associates 2015 Professional Training and Development Symposium, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated February 13, 2015, LAPD requests authority to accept a donation of registration fees for LAPD personnel to attend the Los Angeles Women Police Officers and Associates 2015 Professional Training and Development Symposium. The symposium will address issues of human sex trafficking, bridging the gap between multi-generations in the workplace, overcoming adversity and tragedy, preparing for worst case scenarios of a terrorist attack, and overcoming hurdles and setting goals for a successful career. On February 24, 2015, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At the Public Safety Committee meeting held May 8, 2015, the Committee Chair and Member recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation.
