
Hollywood Forever Cemetery, originally called Hollywood Memorial Park Cemetery, is one of the oldest cemeteries in Los Angeles. It is located adjacent to the north wall, or back, of Paramount Studios.

Among those interred or entombed in the cemetery are a number of important personalities and famous persons, including men and women from the entertainment industry and important people in the history of Los Angeles and their relatives. The cemetery is active and regularly hosts community events, including music events and summer movie screenings.

The Hollywood Forever Cemetery is an important part of our City's history and heritage and as such it is appropriate that the intersection of Santa Monica Boulevard and Gordon Street be named as "Hollywood Forever Plaza."


