MOTION TRANSPORTATION

The neighborhood surrounding the iconic Hollywood Sign has three Preferential Parking Districts which assures parking is available to the residents of the area. As the popularity of the Hollywood Sign continues to increase with the public and tourists, street parking has been adversely impacted the quality of life for these residents in the immediate area.

Access to park in front of their properties, disruption of trash pick-up, street cleaning services, and excessive foot traffic have resulted from the visitors to Upper Beachwood Canyon in hopes to catch a view of the Hollywood Sign.

The residents in the area are publicly requesting immediate relief from this parking problem and have concluded that a modification is needed on the existing Preferential Parking Districts (PPD #184, PPD #186, & PPD#188) to include restrictions on weekdays Monday through Friday.
