

PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT (PLUM) COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the DTLA Forward configuration of streets, detailing the approach to initiating the Phase 2 reconfiguration of Spring Street and Main Street.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. INSTRUCT the Department of City Planning (DCP) to take a larger look at the overall connectivity and configuration of the streets in Downtown Los Angeles as part of the Environmental review of the Downtown Community Plan.
2. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) to report on specific recommendations to improve Spring Street and Main Street.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The LADOT reports that no direct impact to the City's General Fund is anticipated.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

(Transportation Committee waived consideration of the above matter)

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on March 15, 2016, the PLUM Committee considered a report from the LADOT. Staff from the LADOT and the DCP presented information to the Committee. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee approved the reports and added an additional instruction to the DCP. This matter is now submitted to Council for it's consideration.
