At its meeting held June 24, 2015, the Transportation Committee considered Motion (Huizar – Buscaino) relative to improving the pedestrian experience in Downtown Los Angeles. At that time, Committee recommended that Council approve Motion, as amended, to instruct the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to:

1. Report relative to reevaluating the configuration of streets in Downtown Los Angeles, analyzing pedestrian and multimodal transportation options, making Downtown a more walkable and safe environment for pedestrians while improving traffic flow and reducing unneeded vehicular congestion, and discuss how these strategies are consistent with the policies of the Mobility Plan 2035 for the City of Los Angeles.
2. Re-evaluate Downtown Los Angeles street configuration, starting with Spring and Main Streets, between Cesar Chavez Avenue and Olympic Boulevard.
