

BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the 2015-16 FUSE Corps Studies.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on August 3, 2015, the Budget and Finance Committee considered a report from the CAO dated June 23, 2015 relative to the 2015-16 FUSE Corps Studies.

The CAO reports that FUSE Corps is a non-profit organization that seeks to drive and effect change by enlisting talented mid-career professionals and pairing them with civic organizations. FUSE Corps identifies challenges and places the professionals within the organizations in year-long fellowships. The CAO has executed a Master Agreement with FUSE Corps through which any City department can work with FUSE Corps to identify fellowship opportunities. The CAO's report details the studies planned by FUSE Corps with the City for Fiscal Year 2015-16 that include: Reimagining Infrastructure Financing, Establishing Public Libraries as Gateways to Citizenship, and Developing a Coordinated Approach to Homelessness.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee noted and filed the CAO report. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
