MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS/REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL
BOARD/MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM/MOU COST
SHARING AND CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTS QUALITY ACT (CEQA)**

As specified in the Board Report adopted by the Board of Public Works on May 18, 2015, the Bureau of Sanitation is transmitting to the City Council through the City Clerk the final California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Addendum to the Los Angeles County Flood Control District Enhanced Watershed Management Programs Program Environmental Impact Report (CEQA Addendum). As a recommending body, the Board of Public Works considered and forwarded to the City Council a draft CEQA Addendum pursuant to CEQA Guidelines 15025(a), while the Los Angeles County Program Environmental Impact Report ("PEIR") was pending to be finalized and certified by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors.

The Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors in fact certified the PEIR on May 26, 2015, and therefore the draft CEQA Addendum has been revised and finalized (dated May 27, 2015) to reflect the final information. The final CEQA Addendum does not change substantively from the draft version, and includes the final PEIR certified by the County Board of Supervisors.
