

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to prohibiting the parking of vehicles with for sale signs on segments of Washington Boulevard and Normandie Avenue.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Wesson – Price):

REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance amending Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 87.55 to prohibit the parking of vehicles with for sale signs on Washington Boulevard from Kingsley Drive to Manhattan Place, and along Normandie Avenue from 15th Street to Pico Boulevard.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.


SUMMARY

On June 2, 2015, Council considered Motion (Wesson – Price) relative to prohibiting the parking of vehicles with for sale signs on segments of Washington Boulevard and Normandie Avenue. Motion states that there is a critical shortage of on-street parking on Washington Boulevard from Harvard Boulevard to Manhattan Place, and along Normandie Avenue from 15th Street to Pico Boulevard. The situation is exacerbated by individuals parking vehicles for the sole purpose of displaying them for private sale. The congregation of these vehicles is also creating vehicular and pedestrian traffic hazards and traffic congestion along these streets. Motion movers recommend that the City Attorney prepare an ordinance to prohibit the parking of vehicles with for sale signs on these street segments. Council referred Motion to the Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held June 24, 2015, the Transportation Committee discussed this matter with a representative of the Council Office for the Tenth District. The Council Office representative expressed support for the Motion, as amended to modify the Washington Boulevard segment from Kingsley Drive to Manhattan Place. Committee recommended that Council request the City Attorney to prepare the ordinance described above, as amended to incorporate the requested change.
