


MOTION

The Twelfth Council District (CD 12) has received a request to donate 75 handheld Motorola Astro Saber 3 radios to the California Emergency Mobile Patrol (CEMP), a non-profit all-volunteer rescue team based in the San Fernando Valley. As a reserve arm of the Police Department (LAPD), CEMP is on-call 24/7. The mission of CEMP is to volunteer specialized services to those in need. These services include responding to community needs of search and rescue, and aiding with resources for unusual occurrences and general assistance in times of disaster. Section 22.547 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code provides that upon Council approval, surplus City equipment may be sold for less than market value to a non-profit organization located in the City of Los Angeles which has been established exclusively to further the services provided by the City. The radios will be destroyed by LAPD if they are not donated, and therefore, no revenue will be foregone by the City if the donation is approved.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council:

- 1. Find that the California Emergency Mobile Patrol (CEMP) is eligible to purchase 75 handheld Motorola Astro Saber 3 radios at below market value (\$1.00), in accordance with LAAC Sec. 22.547 (Donation of Surplus City Equipment), as the recipient is a non-profit organization located in the City of Los Angeles which has been established exclusively to further the services provided by the City.
- 2. Request the City Attorney to expedite preparation of the appropriate documents to effectuate the sale and transfer of the above identified surplus equipment at below market value to the California Emergency Mobile Patrol; and
- 3. Instruct the City Clerk to inform the California Emergency Mobile Patrol [Michael Panman, California Emergency Mobile Patrol, Post Office Box 924, Reseda, California 91337, (818) 324-5363] that the surplus equipment must be claimed within 60 days from the date of Council approval of the request after which time it will revert to the City's surplus equipment pool for disposal by the Department of General Services.
