

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the dedication of South Central Avenue and East 52nd Street as New Hope Baptist Church Square, and South Central Avenue and East 51st Street as Benjamin J. Bowie Post 228 Square.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Price – Buscaino):

1. DEDICATE the intersections of South Central Avenue and East 52nd Street as New Hope Baptist Church Square, and South Central Avenue and East 51st Street as Benjamin J. Bowie Post 228 Square.
2. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to erect permanent ceremonial sign(s) to this effect at the above locations.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On June 30, 2015, Council considered Motion (Price – Buscaino) relative to the dedication of the street intersections mentioned above. Motion states that Central Avenue in Council District 9 has many historical locations that are of importance to the community. They have made positive contributions by opening their doors to anyone in need of a communal space. Motion movers recommend that the two street intersections above be dedicated to commemorate these contributions. Council referred Motion to the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held August 10, 2015, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee recommended that Council approve Motion.
