

ARTS, PARKS, AND RIVER COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Human Relations Commission, and other local agencies, report on a plan for the City to engage in conversations and activities with regard to race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, diversity, and multiculturalism.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (O'Farrell - Wesson - Harris-Dawson - Ryu):

INSTRUCT the Human Relations Commission, with the assistance of the Cultural Affairs Department, the Los Angeles County Human Relations Commission, the Housing and Community Investment Department, and all relevant non-profits, to report back within 60 days with a plan to engage in conversations and activities throughout the City of Los Angeles with regard to race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, diversity, and multiculturalism.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On August 17, 2015, the Arts, Parks, and River Committee considered Motion (O'Farrell - Wesson - Harris-Dawson - Ryu) relative to the Human Relations Commission, and other local agencies, report on a plan for the City to engage in conversations and activities with regard to race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, diversity, and multiculturalism.

During the discussion of this item, representatives from the Human Relations Commission provided an overview of the matter and responded to related questions from the Committee members.
