

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION and TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEES REPORT relative to transferring \$26,000 for the relocation of two traffic signal boxes and associated cable systems located at the intersection of Santa Ynez Street and Glendale Boulevard in connection with the Echo Park Lake Sidewalk Repair Project.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Controller to transfer and appropriate \$26,000 from the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP), Fund 302/89, Deferred Maintenance Account 89704H to the Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks, Fund 100/94, Account 001090.
2. AUTHORIZE the City Administrative Officer (CAO) to make technical corrections as necessary to effectuate the intent of this action.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that this action will not impact the General Fund. the RAP will transfer \$26,000 to the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) for the performance of the specified services. To the extent applicable, this action complies with City financial policies.

SUMMARY:

In a report to the Mayor dated July 1, 2015, the CAO discusses the proposed transferring of funds for the relocation of two traffic signal boxes and associated cable systems located at the intersection of Santa Ynez Street and Glendale Boulevard in connection with the Echo Park Lake Sidewalk Repair Project. The project includes the removal and replacement of damaged sidewalk surrounding the Echo Park Lake and the installation of Americans with Disabilities Act compliant access ramps at all intersections and access points into Echo Park Lake. On December 10, 2014, the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners approved the proposed transfer of funds from RAP to LADOT. The CAO concurs with this action.

At its meeting held August 10, 2015, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee approved the CAO's recommendations relative to this matter. On August 12, 2015, the Transportation Committee concurred with this action.
