

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 authorizes cities to restrict the parking of vehicles, including but not limited to, those vehicles that are six feet or more in height, on identified City streets during certain hours; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 allows the Council to authorize by resolution, the streets upon which the parking of oversize vehicles shall be restricted between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, an increased problem with oversized vehicles parking in 72-hour zones immediately adjacent to residential and commercial buildings in Council District 5 – these large vehicles are often parked overnight and constrict travel lanes, thereby creating dangerous situations;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council, pursuant to the Municipal Codes Section 80.69.4, and the California Vehicle Code Section 22507 hereby prohibits the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 7 feet in height, during the hours of 2: a.m. and 6:00 a.m., along both sides of the following streets:

- Pontius Ave. from Pico Blvd. to Santa Monica Blvd.
- Cotner Ave. from Pico Blvd. to Santa Monica Blvd.
- Nebraska Ave. from Cotner Ave. to Sepulveda Blvd.
- Missouri Ave. from Cotner Ave. to Sepulveda Blvd.
- La Grange Ave. from Cotner Ave. to Sepulveda Blvd.
- Mississippi Ave. from Cotner Ave. to Sepulveda Blvd.
- Tennessee Ave. from Cotner Ave. to Sepulveda Blvd.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this Resolution, that the Department of Transportation be directed to post the appropriate signs giving notice of a "Tow Away, No Parking, 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. Vehicles over 7 feet high or 22 feet long" restriction for oversize vehicles, on the streets listed above; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this Resolution, that the Department of Transportation be directed to initiate the necessary procedures for the preparation and sale of overnight parking permits, as specified in Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4.(c); and


