Summary: The Harbor City Neighborhood Council is in support of the implementation of higher penalties and enforcement mechanisms to combat illegal dumping activities at apartment buildings. Whereas, in the County of Los Angeles the fines for illegal dumping California Penal Code 374.3 makes illegal dumping on public and private property punishable by a fine up to \$10,000. Also, pursuant to Section 117555 of the California health and Safety Code, a person who dumps illegally is punishable by up to six months on jail. The impact of illegal dumping activities contributes to the large homeless encampments in our neighborhoods which contain large bulky items such as mattresses, couches, refrigerators and so forth. Therefore, causing Neighborhood Councils to take action by implementing line items in their budgets for community clean ups to combat this issue.
