

PERSONNEL AND ANIMAL WELFARE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to workers' compensation fraud investigation statistics.

Recommendation for Council action:

INSTRUCT the Personnel Department and REQUEST the City Attorney to work with workers' compensation providers and report with a framework on what elements to look into regarding workers' compensation fraud and abuse, including a detailed and comprehensive forensic audit, with guidelines as to changes and recommendations, and how to adopt the changes into a new Request for Proposal (RFP) for future providers.


Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on February 21, 2018, the Personnel and Animal Welfare Committee considered a CAO report regarding fraud investigations of workers' compensation cases. Representatives from the CAO Office and City Attorney provided the Committee statistical information regarding fraud claims, including how many were investigated and how many were prosecuted. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended for the Personnel Department and the City Attorney to report back with a more detailed and comprehensive report, including requested changes and recommendations, and how to incorporate the changes in the RFP. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
