

MOTION

Residential areas throughout the City of Los Angeles have been inundated by valet services that are hired for events at private residences that are held in neighboring "no parking" areas. This has created public safety related concerns for the surrounding impacted neighborhoods.

Valet parking operators performing services for events at private residences currently are exempt from the operating requirements imposed by a police permit.

Council District 5 has engaged in working with the valet companies to eliminate this problem by requesting valet companies to conduct their services from private parking lots or structures. While this effort has reduced the volume, the parking problem and other nuisance and public safety concerns persists.

To address these concerns some cities require valet parking operators to obtain a one-day or short term valet permit in order to provide valet service at a private residence. This is necessary to protect the interests of the city and the peace, health, and safety of the public.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council REQUEST the City Attorney to draft an ordinance that would create a one-day or short term permit for valet parking operators that provide valet services for events at private residences.
