TRANSPORTATION

On April 5, 2011, the Council approved the addition of Section 87.55 to Chapter VIII of the Los Angeles Municipal Code that establishes regulations for the parking of vehicles displaying a "For Sale" sign or placard advertising the private sale of that vehicle. After conducting a public hearing, Section 87.55 allows the City Council to amend this Section to include additional streets or public lands.

A large number of vehicles are consistently parked for the sole purpose of displaying them for private sale on the following street segments:

- The eastern side of Sepulveda Boulevard between San Jose Street and Chatsworth Street;
- Hubbard Street between Glenoaks Boulevard and Herrick Avenue; and
- Van Nuys Boulevard between Remick Avenue and Laurel Canyon Boulevard.

Residents and businesses in these communities are experiencing problems with these vehicles because they monopolize on-street parking, create visual blight, and cause vehicular and pedestrian traffic hazards.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council request the City Attorney to prepare and present an ordinance amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 87.55, which establishes regulations for the parking of vehicles for private sale on certain City streets or public lands, to prohibit the parking of such vehicles on the east side of Sepulveda Boulevard between San Jose Street and Chatsworth Street; both sides of Hubbard Street between Glenoaks Boulevard and Herrick Avenue; and both sides of Van Nuys Boulevard between Remick Avenue and Laurel Canyon Boulevard.
