

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the recordation of a nonstandard component for the Alliance College-Ready Public School expansion project.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Price - Huizar):

DIRECT the Bureau of Engineering to issue a revocable permit for the Alliance College-Ready Public School expansion project, located at 9719 South Main Street, for the recording of a nonstandard component of the project.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On November 24, 2015, Council considered Motion (Price - Huizar) relative to the recordation of a nonstandard component for the Alliance College-Ready Public School expansion project. Motion states that the project requires a setback dedication. Concerns exist regarding existing bougainvillea plants located partially in the public right-of-way. The school reports that the bougainvillea beautifies the right-of-way and acts as a graffiti deterrent. Motion goes on to state that the school is committed to maintaining it away from the edge of the sidewalk. City regulations, however, do not allow plants with spines, thorns, sharp points, or edges in a public right-of-way. Alliance College-Ready Public School agrees to assume all liability that may arise from thorny plants within the public right-of-way. Motion directs the Bureau of Engineering to issue a revocable permit for the project. Council referred Motion to the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee for consideration.

At its special meeting held December 14, 2015, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee recommended that Council approve Motion.
