

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to naming the intersection at 38th Street and Griffith Avenue as Charlena D. Price Square.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Price – O’Farrell):

1. APPROVE the naming of the intersection at 38th Street and Griffith Avenue as Charlena D. Price Square.
2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to erect permanent ceremonial sign(s) to this effect at this location.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On December 11, 2015, Council considered Motion (Price – O’Farrell) relative to naming the intersection at 38th Street and Griffith Avenue as Charlena D. Price Square. Motion states Ms. Price was an advocate for K-12 education, neighborhood empowerment, and community building. The naming of the intersection of 38th Street and Griffith Avenue as Charlena D. Price Square will commemorate her robust contributions to making the City of Los Angeles a better place for all of us. Motion movers recommend that Council approve the proposed intersection naming. Council referred Motion to the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held January 25, 2016, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee recommended that Council approve Motion’s instructions relative to this matter.
