In December 2004, the Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) Board of Airport Commissioners approved a Cooperation Agreement with the Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) Coalition for Economic, Environmental and Educational Justice. This agreement includes measures to mitigate noise, pollutant emissions and traffic impacts of the LAX Master Plan. In accordance with the Cooperation Agreement guidelines, *LAWA is required to provide an annual report on progress of the LAX Master Plan Program.*


I am pleased to submit to you LAWA's tenth Community Benefits Agreement (CBA) 2014 Annual Progress Report. Some highlights for the year include:

- Provided over \$39 million in funding to the County of Los Angeles and City of Inglewood for residential sound insulation
- Completed sound attenuation of Felton Elementary in the Lennox School District and began work on Jefferson and Buford Elementary Schools
- Registered over 20,000 people on the Applicant Tracking System with the First Source Hiring Program and 2,150 candidates referred to prospective employers
- Recycled 155,383 tons of construction concrete

In keeping with LAWA's sustainability goals, the report is now posted on LAWA's website at www.ourlax.com.

The annual progress report provides the status of applicable Agreement provisions currently being implemented at LAX. LAWA will continue to monitor and report annually on LAX Master Plan mitigation compliance projects and the CBA.
