Subject: AUTHORITY TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, NEGOTIATE, AND EXECUTE AGREEMENTS FOR GRANT FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY FOR ALTERNATIVE FUEL VEHICLE PROGRAMMATIC SUPPORT OF THE LOS ANGELES CLEAN CITIES COALITION

As recommended in the accompanying report of the Director of the Bureau of Sanitation, which this Board has adopted, the Board of Public Works requests that the City Council, subject to concurrence of the Mayor, authorize the Director of the Bureau of Sanitation, or his designee, to execute and submit all documents, including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, or amendments, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality, which may be necessary to secure grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$180,000 for alternative fuel vehicle programmatic support for the period November 16, 2015 until December 31, 2019.

It is also requested, that the Bureau of Sanitation continue to participate in the Clean Cities Program by completing the re-designation process with the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) expected to begin during Fiscal Year 2016-2017; It is also requested, to authorize the Bureau of Sanitation to receive, if awarded, grant funds from the U.S. DOE or other selected U.S. DOE vendor and appropriate up to \$45,000 each fiscal year starting Fiscal Year 2015-2016 to Fiscal Year 2019-2020 totaling up to \$180,000 in the Environmental Affairs Trust Fund, Fund 537, Dept. 50, New Account (Clean Cities – Program Support); It is further requested, to authorize the Bureau of Sanitation to transfer and appropriate \$35,000 each fiscal year from the Environmental Affairs Trust Fund, Fund 537, Dept. 50, New Account (Clean Cities – Program Support) to Fund 100, Dept. 82 as shown in the accompanying report.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no impact to the City's General Fund. If awarded, the Environmental Affairs Trust Fund will provide front funding for the grant and be reimbursed through grant receipts.
