DISCUSSION

The donation is for the benefit of Major Crimes Division (MCD). The requested equipment will be utilized by the MCD Cyber Intelligence Unit to conduct cyber intelligence investigations for the Los Angeles Police Department (Department). Due to the sensitive and complex nature of these investigations, which include counter-terrorism incidents and threats to public officials, the Cyber Unit needs the best tools available to work in a safe and expeditious manner. This equipment will afford the Cyber Unit the most flexibility and security while the unit works to combat the threat of terrorism throughout the City and County of Los Angeles. Major Crimes Division has a restricted fund with the Los Angeles Police Foundation (Foundation). The Foundation will use funds from this account to pay for the equipment. This equipment comes with a three-year warranty, and additional donations will be sought for any repairs outside the warranty period. Senior Systems Analyst Karen Bottancino of Information Technology Bureau has advised that the technology meets Department and City standards.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Department patents.

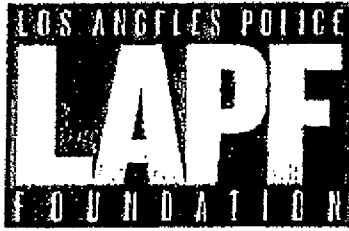


