

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of gym equipment for the benefit of the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Central Area, Operations-Central Bureau, and Gang and Narcotics Division.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the donation of gym equipment, valued at \$32,250.60, from the LAPD 77th Street Charitable Foundation, Inc., for the benefit of the LAPD Central Area, Operations-Central Bureau, and Gang and Narcotics Division; and, THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners (Board). Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board dated January 27, 2017, attached to the Council file, the LAPD recommends that the Board approve the donation of gym equipment from the LAPD Foundation 77th Street Charitable Foundation, Inc. for the benefit of the LAPD Central Area, Operations-Central Bureau, and Gang and Narcotics Division. The LAPD reports that the donated items will enable law enforcement personnel to maintain good physical health. There are no maintenance costs associated with this equipment, and should the equipment break or fail, there will be no repair or replacement. At the meeting held on March 21, 2017, your Public Safety Committee considered this matter. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee recommended that Council approve the donation of gym equipment for the benefit of the LAPD Central Area, Operations-Central Bureau, and Gang and Narcotics Division, as recommended by the Board, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
