

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a monetary donation to be used to pay for improvements to the building located at 3320 West 36th Street, for the benefit of the Los Angeles Metropolitan Task Force on Violent Gangs.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT a monetary donation in the amount of \$18,685 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation to be used to pay for improvements to the building located at 3320 West 36th Street, for the benefit of the Los Angeles Metropolitan Task Force on Violent Gangs; and, THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners (BOPC). Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

In a report to the BOPC dated April 23, 2019 (attached to the Council file), the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) is requesting authority to accept a monetary donation in the amount of \$18,685 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation to be used to pay for improvements to the building located at 3320 West 36th Street. The building is to be used in the day to day operations of the Los Angeles Metropolitan Task Force on Violent Gangs. On April 30, 2019, the BOPC approved the LAPD's request. Subsequently, on August 14, 2019, the Committee considered this matter and after having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend authorizing the LAPD to accept the donation. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
