

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the establishment of parking restrictions for oversized vehicles in Del Rey.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Resolution (Bonin - Buscaino):

1. RESOLVE, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 80.69.4 and California Vehicle Code (CVC) Section 22507, to hereby prohibit the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 AM and 6:00 AM, along the following streets:
 - a. Westlawn Avenue from Short Avenue to Louise Avenue
 - b. Beethoven Avenue from Short Avenue to Panama Avenue
 - c. Culver Drive between Inglewood Boulevard and Mesmer Avenue
 - d. Sanford Street from Inglewood Boulevard to the end of the cul-de-sac
 - e. 1000 block of Princeton Drive between Carter Avenue and the end of the street
 - f. Beethoven Avenue from Short Avenue to Panama Street
2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon approval of this action, to post signs giving notice of a Tow Away, No Parking restriction for oversized vehicles on the streets lists above in Recommendation No. 1.
3. DIRECT the LADOT, upon adoption of this Resolution, to initiate the necessary procedures for the preparation and sale of overnight parking permits, as specified in LAMC Section 80.69.4(c).
4. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this action.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the LADOT. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On January 27, 2016, your Committee considered a Resolution (Bonin - Buscaino) relative to the establishment of parking restrictions for oversized vehicles in Del Rey. Specifically, the streets are:

- a. Westlawn Avenue from Short Avenue to Louise Avenue
- b. Beethoven Avenue from Short Avenue to Panama Avenue
- c. Culver Drive between Inglewood Boulevard and Mesmer Avenue

- d. Sanford Street from Inglewood Boulevard to the end of the cul-de-sac
- e. 1000 block of Princeton Drive between Carter Avenue and the end of the street

According to the Resolution, CVC Section 22507 authorizes cities to restrict the parking of vehicles, including but not limited to, those vehicles that are six feet or more in height, on identified City streets during certain hours and LAMC Code Section 80.69.4 allows Council to authorize by resolution, the streets upon which the parking of oversize vehicles shall be restricted between 2:00 am and 6:00 am. Finally, there is an increased problem with oversized vehicles parking in Del Rey, immediately adjacent to residential buildings, and these large vehicles are often parked overnight and constrict travel lanes thereby creating dangerous situations.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend adoption of the Resolution as detailed above and attached to the Council File. Additionally, the Committee moved to amend the Resolution to add: Beethoven Avenue from Short Avenue to Panama Street. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
