

MOTION


The Beachwood Canyon area is a residential community in the Hollywood Hills that includes several historic small businesses. Due to its proximity to Griffith Park and the Hollywood Sign, the area experiences frequent traffic congestion that makes public safety and parking problematic for residents, tourists, and customers. The Department should examine the feasibility of establishing time limited parking restrictions and the installation of parking meters in the area, as well as opportunities to enhance pedestrian, cyclist and driver safety in Beachwood Canyon.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council direct the Department of Transportation to initiate a parking study and report back with recommendations for the installation of:

- 1) time limit parking signs on the following block faces: North Beachwood Drive, Belden Drive; and any other adjacent streets requiring parking congestion mitigation measures; and
- 2) parking meters on North Beachwood Drive and Belden Drive.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Council direct the Department of Transportation to initiate a study on pedestrian, cyclist and driver safety at the intersection of North Beachwood Drive, Belden Drive and Westshire Drive in the Hollywood Hills, and report back with recommendations to enhance public safety for the residents of the Beachwood Canyon community.
