

MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations of the City Attorney in order to effect settlement in the case entitled Edsell Ford, et al. v. City of Los Angeles, et al., Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. BC574800 (this matter arises from an incident involving members of the Los Angeles Police Department on August 11, 2014, in Los Angeles, California), **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to pay \$1,500,000 in settlement of the above-entitled matter.
2. FIND that the settlement is in the best interests of the City.
3. FIND that the City intends to make an interfund borrowing or advance from the Reserve Fund to pay the settlement on an interim basis, which loan or advance will be refunded or reimbursed with the proceeds of a judgment obligation bond issue, and a resolution will be presented in open session at a later date.
4. AUTHORIZE the Controller to transfer \$1,500,000 from the Reserve Fund to the Unappropriated Balance and appropriate therefrom to Liability Claims Fund No. 100/59 Police Liability Payouts, Account No. 009792, to be reimbursed by proceeds from a future Judgment Obligation Bond issuance.
5. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to draw a demand for \$1,500,000 from Liability Claims Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009792, Police Liability Payouts, and made payable to: Abir Cohen Treyzon Salo, LLP; Steve A. Lerman and Associates, Inc.; and Tritobia Ford and Edsell Ford.
6. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to prepare Controller instructions for any necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer; and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.
