Summary: The Greater Valley Glen Council Board again expresses its support for the ongoing research partnership to evaluate investments and technologies for achieving a 100% renewable energy portfolio by the LADWP but additionally adds that study credibility demands that due consideration be given to scenarios brought forward by members of the Advisory Group Participants. Accordingly, the scenario that includes achieving the 100% goal by the year 2030 and that study assumptions exclude any use of methane, biomass, biogas, nuclear energy, and unbundled renewable energy credits should be given a fair evaluation. As in our original CIS, the costs associated with all scenarios must be an integral part of the study conclusions and additionally add here that reliability of service must not be degraded.
