

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a grant award from the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department for participation in the Los Angeles County Regional Human Trafficking Task Force Program.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Chief, Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), or designee, to:
  - a. Retroactively apply for and accept the 2015 Los Angeles Regional Human Trafficking Task Force grant award in the amount of \$200,000 from the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department for the period of October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2018.
  - b. Negotiate and execute the 2015 Los Angeles Regional Human Trafficking Task Force Funding Agreement on behalf of the City and submit all necessary documents relative to the grant award, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
  
2. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to:
  - a. Spend up to the grant amount of \$200,000 in accordance with the grant award agreement.
  - b. Submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit grant receipts in Police Department Grants Fund No. 339/70.
  
3. AUTHORIZE the Controller to:
  - a. Establish a grant receivable and appropriate \$200,000 to appropriation account, account number to be determined, within Fund No. 339/70, for disbursement of the 2015 Los Angeles Regional Human Trafficking Task Force grant funds.
  - b. Increase appropriation from Fund No. 339/70 for the 2015 Los Angeles Regional Human Trafficking Task Force, account number to be determined within Fund No. 100/70, account number and amount as follows:

4. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO); and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

Fiscal Impact Statement Submitted: The CAO reports that approval of the recommendations in this report will have no additional impact on the General Fund. Acceptance of the grant is in compliance with the City's Financial Policies in that one-time revenue is used for one-time expenses.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary

At the meeting held on August 2, 2016, the Public Safety Committee considered reports from the Board of Police Commissioners and the CAO relative to a grant award from the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department for participation in the Los Angeles County Regional Human Trafficking Task Force Program. An opportunity for public comment was held. After further discussion of the matter, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the CAO report. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
