

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION, TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to the amendment of boundaries for Temporary Preferential Parking District (TPPD) No. 215.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. FIND that the amendment of boundaries for TPPD No. 215, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 80.58.d, is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as a Class 1 Categorical Exemption, under Article III.1.a.3 of the 2002 Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
2. FIND that the original establishment of TPPD No. 215 within Hancock Park in Council District Four did not include an older building at 601 N. Rossmore Avenue whose only parking option for their residents is street parking.
3. FIND that no parking permit restrictions have been posted for Rosewood Avenue between Lillian Way and Cahuenga Boulevard and that the removal of this street segment will not impact residents on this street segment.
4. ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION, pursuant to LAMC Section 80.58, amending the boundaries of TPPD No. 215 to:
 - a. Remove Rosewood Avenue between Cahuenga Boulevard and Lillian Way
 - b. Add Clinton Street between Rossmore Avenue and Lillian Way
5. EXTEND the effective date of the permits for TPPD No. 215 an additional one year from the effective date of the new boundaries.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The LADOT reports that revenue from the sale of permits will cover the cost of implementing and administering TPPD No. 215. If motorists are cited for violating the posted signs, some additional General Fund revenue could result.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On September 14, 2016, your Committee considered a September 2, 2016 LADOT report and Resolution relative to the amendment of boundaries for TPPD No. 215. Specifically, the amendment is to include the removal of Rosewood Avenue between Cahuenga Boulevard and Lillian Way and the addition of Clinton Street between Rossmore Avenue and Lillian Way. According to the LADOT, on May 24, 2016, Council established TPPD No. 215 which includes residential portions of:

- a. Lillian Way between Rosewood Avenue and Clinton Street
- b. Lillian Way between Clinton Street and Melrose Avenue

- c. Clinton Street between Lillian Way and Cahuenga Boulevard
- d. The northside of Rosewood Avenue between Lillian Way and Cahuenga Boulevard
- e. Cahuenga Boulevard between Rosewood Avenue and Clinton Street.

On August 18, 2016, the Councilmember for Council District Four sent a letter to the LADOT stating that the establishment of TPPD No. 215 omitted 601 N. Rossmore Avenue and prevented the residents of this building from being able to park on the street. There seems to be no other viable measures to address the parking issue other than to change the boundary. As TPPD No. 215 already contains the maximum number of five blocks, one block must be removed. The Councilmember is requesting the addition of Clinton Street between Lillian Way and Rossmore Avenue and the removal of Rosewood Avenue between Cahuenga Boulevard and Lillian Way. A map of the TPPD with the revised boundary is attached to the September 2, 2016 LADOT report.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the recommendations as detailed above. Additionally, a recommendation was made to extend the renewal date of the permits for TPPD no. 215 for an additional one year from the effective date of the new boundaries. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
