## RESOLUTION ESTABLISHMENT OF OVERSIZE VEHICLE RESTRICTED STREETS IN DEL REY

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 authorizes cities to restrict the parking of vehicles, including but not limited to, those vehicles that are six feet or more in height, on identified City streets during certain hours; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 allows the Council to authorize by resolution, the streets upon which the parking of oversize vehicles shall be restricted between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Del Rey community is experiencing public safety issues associated with large vehicles parked adjacent to residential buildings on portions of Culver Drive and Westlawn Avenue, which are parked overnight and constrict travel lanes thereby creating dangerous situations;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council, pursuant to the Municipal Code Section 80.69.4, and the California Vehicle Code Section 22507 hereby prohibits the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 7 feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m., along both sides of:

- Culver Drive between Mesmer Avenue and Inglewood Boulevard; and
- Westlawn Avenue between Walsh Avenue and Greene Avenue.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of the Resolution, the Department of Transportation be directed to post signs giving notice of a "tow away, no parking" restriction for oversized vehicles, with the specific hours detailed, at the above locations.

BEIT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation be authorized to make technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
