

ENTERTAINMENT AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the City's bike-share program and its potential impact on film production companies.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Martinez - Bonin):

1. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) to report on:
 - a. Whether the bike-share stations located near popular film locations may be easily removed, relocated and replaced by the film production companies upon the completion of filming and the costs associated with such activities.
 - b. Any coordination efforts that may need to be implemented between LADOT, FilmL.A., Inc., and the entertainment industry in order to ensure that the bike-share stations will not significantly impact film productions and bike riders.
2. INSTRUCT the LADOT to report with an update on how the department and the film community address the issues that arise regarding filming and bike-share stations during the first year of the pilot program.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a meeting held on June 14, 2016, the Entertainment and Facilities Committee considered Motion (Martinez - Bonin) relative to the City's bike-share program and its potential impact on film production companies. During the discussion of this item, representatives from the LADOT responded to related questions from the Committee members.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council approve the Motion as amended in Committee and detailed above. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
