

MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations of the City Attorney in order to effect settlement in the case entitled Travelers Commercial Insurance Company v. City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. BC565696 (this matter arises from a sewer backup at 17410 Revello Drive, Pacific Palisades, in October 2013 [Council District 11]), **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

1. APPROVE settlement of the Plaintiff's claims in the amount of \$171,143.
2. AUTHORIZE the Director, Bureau of Sanitation, or designee, to execute a settlement agreement to be prepared by the City Attorney to implement the settlement.
3. AUTHORIZE and INSTRUCT the City Attorney, without further instructions, to draw a demand warrant in the amount of \$171,143 from Public Works, Sanitation Liability Payouts Fund No. 100/59, Account 009794, payable to Travelers Commercial Insurance Company, **payable after July 1, 2016.**
4. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to prepare Controller instructions for any necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer; and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

This matter was recommended for approval by the Budget and Finance Committee (Krekorian – Blumenfield – Bonin: "Yes") at its meeting on June 27, 2016, in Closed Session as permitted by Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(1).
